

Angela Andáy's biography

Angela Andáy (concertsinger, contralto) graduated in both Teaching and Performance ('91/93) after studying at the Conservatories of Music in Amsterdam and Antwerp. As requested by Aafje Heynis, foundations have selected her for several stipends. She studied with Cora Canne Meijer, Luciënne Van Deyck, Vera Rózsa and at invitation with Christa Ludwig. This natural coloratura-contralto performed the world's first performances of major works especially composed for her by Marc van Delft. She has sung oratorios and symphonic works with conductors as Jules van Hessen, Benjamin Ashkenazy, Christian Mandeal, Ludo Claesen and Johannes Keller. She has given recitals with pianists as Phillis Ferwerda and Tomás Visek (Prague), has sung in Israël and 7 European countries and has been recorded as a soloist for radio, television and CD. Aukeline van Hoytema of the Dutch classical Radio put this contralto in 'The CD Top 10' among Placido Domingo, Kiri te Kanawa and Jessye Norman.
